- Prevent, control and minimize significant environmental aspects, especially those derived from the waste generation, through the application of appropriate, feasible organizational and technological measures.
- Integrate, as much as possible, its quality management, environment and prevention systems in all activities that are carried out in within the company.
- Provide the human, technical and economic resources, along with the allocation of the center's equity capital, to allow the proper implementation of this policy.
- Involve all company personnel in management responsibilities regarding occupational risk prevention, involving contractors and associates in an active commitment to improve the working conditions of their employees.

- Work in our washing protocol to minimize generation of wash water.
- Establish a commitment with continuous improvement in these matters, as well as with behaviors and levels of prevention of occupational risks and pollution.
- Review our comprehensive policy in order to adapt it to new technologies and the demands by context and stakeholders.
